Here is the message sent to the McGill community on February 10, 2014:

Nominations for the position of the Ombudsperson for Students are invited for a term beginning September 1, 2014. The Ombudsperson's primary responsibility is to provide an independent, impartial and confidential process through which students may seek the just, fair and equitable resolution of any university-related concern where normal non-adversarial administrative channels for addressing such matters are inappropriate in the circumstances or prove ineffective.

Candidates for this position should hold a tenure-track academic appointment at McGill University, be well respected by both students and other members of the McGill community, and be familiar with the University and its policies and procedures. Facility in both English and French is desirable.

The post of the Ombudsperson for Students is a half-time appointment with a non-renewable five-year term. An office and secretarial support for the Ombudsperson are provided by the University.

Nominations or application for this position will be considered as they are received until the position is filled. Nominations and applications may be submitted to my attention via mail to HR.DPSLL@mcgill.ca. All such communications will, of course, be kept in the strictest confidence.
