Events

Arts Health and Wellness Week

AHAW is a new mental health awareness project jointly organized by the AUS and Arts OASIS. AHAW originated out of ArtsDAR's Seeds of Change campaign last April. It stands for Arts Health and Wellness. The first event is AHAWeek, which will be a series of self-care activities from September 29th to October 3rd. Some examples include a ice cream give away on Thursday which we will run out of the AUS lounge and a free yoga session on Friday in the SSMU building.

Faculty Affairs

Administration and Building

I met with Associate Dean Gillian Lane-Mercier to talk about faculty affairs. Gillian works in administrative oversight for the faculty, which means she is highly involved in the PPP project, which I believe has just been completed last week.

Currently administrative units are settling into their new locations in the Faculty. The project involved a lot of furniture relocation. I expressed concerns about the furniture in the basement of Leacock and was told that it will soon be moved out. However, that furniture is also up for grabs, so if you are a departmental executive looking for furniture, you can look around to see if there are pieces you would like. Gillian and I discussed that you then inform your departmental administrative office, who can help you locate a mover resource. Then you take the bill for the mover and the AUS reimburses you. The gist of this is that the faculty provides the furniture and we pay for the furniture to be moved.

Leacock 111/112

There will be six TA booths installed in 111 and couches put into the center of the room to create a lounge area. I am also looking into enhancing the lighting of 111, as it is rather dim.
