EPIC

- ❖ The EPIC Application closed last night

- ❖ We had some problems last Thursday. There were a lot of staff present during clean up and it made things rather difficult. We met informally as managers over the weekend to discuss ways to prevent this from happening in the future. Some things we've decided to do are limit the number of people who stay for clean-up, be more forceful with our strike policy (we had some people trying to sneak friends in at the end of the night), and communicate more openly with staff about our goals
- ❖ On a brighter note, the invoice from last week's BdA was less than \$200 (compared to upwards of a thousand dollars in previous invoices). So we're making financial progress!

- ❖ Meeting next Tuesday, November 4th, with the Internals to discuss the results of the after-frosh survey.
- ❖ Met with Equity Commissioners to discuss the creation of an ad-hoc frosh bylaw review committee and ended up deciding we should make more broad Events bylaws rather than just for frosh. We felt it would institutionalize things a bit more concretely and, in order to do things right, we've decided to take the whole year to come up with some good bylaws – they won't be in this referendum period but they'll be in the next one in the winter!
