Description:

The Faculty wishes to continue the positive trend of providing physical infrastructure necessary for our students in our buildings. The benches in the Arts and Leacock Buildings are in constant use by students. The provision of these eighteen (18*) new benches in Arts and Leacock will increase the seating available in two of the highest traffic areas in the Faculty. They will also provide a relatively quieter place to sit and review or discuss material before or after class. These additional benches will thereby add significantly to the resources normally provided by the University and used by Arts students.

*Included in this total are several old benches in the Arts and Leacock Buildings that have been determined by Facilities to be unstable. The cost of refurbishing them would be equivalent to or greater than the cost of purchasing new ones. We have included the replacement of these unstable benches in the total number requested. The replacement benches will upgrade the appearance of our most public areas and will eliminate any potential danger to students from a rickety bench.

Security:

As the benches are quite large and very heavy, we can assume, as with the other benches already in place, they would not be moved.


