



Notice: Resignation of Arts Representative to SSMU September 3rd, 2015

We, the AUS Executive, would like to inform our members about the resignation of Arts Representative to SSMU Samiha Sharif for personal reasons. The resignation is official and effective as of September 3rd, 2015. The replacement process will be discussed at the next session of AUS Legislative Council on September 9th. Until a replacement is selected, another member of AUS Council will attend SSMU Council meetings.

Replacement measures are conducted per the AUS Constitution and Electoral By-Laws. As following the AUS Constitution, Article 12.14,

12.14 “In the event that one of the Arts Representatives to SSMU positions is or becomes vacant, the Council shall elect a replacement, in accordance with the Electoral by-laws, from amongst its members until a by-election, if deemed necessary, is held.”

AUS Council will discuss the replacement process on September 9th at 6:00 PM in Leacock 232. Council is open to the public, and we encourage you to attend.

The description of the Arts Representative role as per the AUS constitution is as follows:

7.2 The Arts Representatives to SSMU Council shall:

- a. Be voting members of SSMU Council and be bound by the SSMU Constitution and by-laws;*
- b. Consult with AUS council and reasonably represent the prevailing views of Council at SSMU Council meetings;*
- c. Report the relevant and/or important discussions and decisions of SSMU to Council and of Council to SSMU;*
- d. Serve as a liaison between Arts students and the SSMU;*
- e. Each Arts Representative must sit on at least one of the following committees: Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty of Arts, the Curriculum Committee of the Faculty of Arts, or the Faculty of Arts Committee;*
- f. Liaise and collaborate with the Executive Committee to improve representation and service provision for AUS members.*
