



## **REPORT OF THE AUS VP FINANCE – JANUARY 27<sup>th</sup> 2015**

### **ARTS UNDERGRADUATE IMPROVEMENT FUND:**

- Have received 10 applications so far. The library's proposal, which constitutes majority of the fund, will be coming in on the 29<sup>th</sup> of January only.
- The Steering Committee met on Monday, 25<sup>th</sup> January to veto proposals and will be meeting again on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> January.
- Departmental associations need to nominate 11 student representatives to sit on the AUIFC. I am still looking for student members to sit on the committee – should be finalized very shortly.

### **FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:**

- First meeting was held January 22<sup>nd</sup>
- Over 18 applications were reviewed on the first meeting – many of those were tabled due to lack of information. As of today, there is \$23,000 left in the fund.
- FMC has nominated Luke Steverango and Margo Budline to sit on the AUS VP Finance Screening Committee.

### **OTHER TASKS:**

- In the process of arranging a meeting with auditors, Fuller Landau to map out the timeline for the annual audit of 2015 – 2016.
- Met the Arts Internship Office (AIO) on January 18<sup>th</sup> to go over funding sources for the ARIA program. They will be applying to the AUIF for more funding.
- Met the VP Academic to go over Peer Tutoring applications for the Winter semester and was present at the FAC meeting last Tuesday.
- Accounting, as usual.
