Be it resolved, that all motions put to vote at the AUS Legislative Council have all insertions **marked in bold**, have all deletions ~~marked with a strikethrough~~, be clearly marked as to if they obtained successful passage, and be uploaded to the AUS website within 48 hours following the conclusion of a meeting of the AUS Legislative Council except in the event of technical failure. A secondary copy, showing the final state of a motion, without mark up shall also be uploaded.
