We have already held a successful wine and cheese and language exchange so far this year, and we are looking to continue our popular events. Next Thursday, November 2nd, we will be hosting a film screening of "Under the Sun", a documentary giving insight to the North Korean state and the effects of propaganda on everyday people living there. We hope to have a professor of Korean studies come and help lead a discussion with our students after the screening, adding an academic side to it as well. Furthermore, we will be hosting our second Language Exchange on Tuesday, November 7th. We will have native speakers of Korean, Japanese, and Mandarin coming to help lead conversations and practice their languages with students interested or currently enrolled in the East Asian language courses here at McGill. We are also currently looking for Peer Tutors to hire for the semester to help tutor students in Korean, Mandarin, and Japanese.
