

Motion to Accept Revised Interpretation of Definition of Executive Committee

Whereas, the AUS Constitution states:

11.2 The Executive Committee shall be composed of:

- a. The President;
- b. The Vice-President Academic;
- ... h. The Arts Representatives to SSMU.

11.3 Arts Representatives to SSMU will serve as non-voting members of the Executive Committee.

Whereas, when the Constitution was amended to include the Arts Representatives on the Executive Committee in the fall of 2015, they were not considered members of the Executive Committee for purposes of work study;

Whereas, the Constitution further states:

11.6.1 To improve accessibility to positions on the AUS Executive Committee outlined in Article 11.2, members of the AUS Executive Committee who demonstrate financial need in accordance with McGill Work Study eligibility criteria shall be eligible for remuneration for their tenure on the AUS Executive Committee through the AUS Work Study Program (AUS WSP).

Whereas, there is a motion to AUS Legislative Council on October 25th to remove the Arts Representatives from the Accountability Committee via referendum;

Whereas, if this motion passes, Arts Representatives will be eligible for work study compensation at a rate of \$11.25 per hour;

Be it resolved, that the AUS Legislative Council accept the interpretation Article 11 of the AUS' Constitution to include Arts Representatives as members, albeit non-voting of the AUS' Executive committee, and thus eligible for work study, however, not holding seats on the AUS' Board of Directors.
