



## Motion to Amend the Role of the Arts Representatives to SSMU via Referendum

**Whereas**, the role of the Arts Representative was most recently amended in 2015, at which time the Arts Representatives became non-voting members of the AUS' Executive Committee;

**Whereas**, at that time, AUS Council did not consider the language of the referendum question to allow Arts Representatives to be eligible for work study compensation;

**Whereas**, work study compensation makes the position more accessible to students wishing to run for the position in the future and recognizes that the nature of the job ;

**Whereas**, there is a motion to AUS Legislative Council on October 25th to allow for Arts Representatives to be eligible for work-study;

**Whereas**, if Arts Representatives are to be compensated, they should not be a designated member of the committee reviewing their timesheets;
