



Motion to Approve the Amended AGELF Constitution

Whereas, there are a number of inconsistencies in definitions in the current constitution;

Whereas, the current constitution does not make use of inclusive language;

Whereas, the current constitution does not make any reference to the departmental elections' online-voting system;

Whereas, the current constitution does not make any reference to alternative electoral proceedings, such as nominations, which are referenced in the AUS Constitution;

Whereas, the current constitution does not provide a General Assembly quorum;

Whereas, the current constitution's rules for dividing up a vacant position's responsibilities are inefficient and impractical;

Whereas, the current constitution has not been amended since its adoption;

Be it resolved, that the Arts Undergraduate Society Legislative Council approve the proposed amendments to the AGELF Constitution in Appendix C.
