Motion to Strike a Working Group for the INVOLVEMENT RESTRICTION POLICY

WHEREAS, The Involvement Restriction Policy, hereafter referred to as the IRP, has been brought forward at the Arts Undergraduate Society legislative council, on 14th November but there warrants further consultation with AUS Equity Committee and other members of the community;

WHEREAS, the IRP is time sensitive due to a current case and there is a potential for inter-faculty reference and usage;

WHEREAS, the labour, work and hours put into this working group will be accounted for when calculating new stipends for the Equity Commissioners and Secretary General;

BE IT RESOLVED, A working group is struck to review the Involvement Restriction Policy between November 14 and November 21 to make revisions to the policy,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The conclusions of the working group will be voted on online between November 22 and 23,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the working group will be chaired by the Secretary General,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the working group be comprised of any councillor wishing to sit in on the working group, every executive, the Equity Commissioners, and the Secretary General,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any individual mandated to be in the working group absent from the meeting of the working group write their recommendations down to have it recorded for future accountability and to have them made available to other individuals in the working group,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the working group meet in a private and confidential space,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all members of the working group will sign an Non Disclosure Agreement with the AUS when discussing confidential lived experiences of executive members and Equity Commissioners who speak to how the IRP is structured,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the working group meet at least once in this time period to address current concerns.
