### **General**

- Held a townhall-style meeting on 7 October to discuss upcoming events, particularly the Wine and Cheese and sorted out issues with Server Training.
- Second meeting held on 15 October to apply for external funding.

### **Events**

- Wine and Cheese event scheduled for 18 October at 16h in the Birks building.
  - Figured out issue with Server Training equitability, alternate training on 17 Oct.
  - Time changed from 14h to 16h.
- Bronfman took two weeks to get back to us about our bake sale table booking and we didn't even get it. Now have reached out to the Education building for a booking.

### **Internal Affairs**

- Gender neutral bathrooms
  - Originally suggested by TUSA, the third floor Birks bathrooms will (hopefully) soon be gender neutral bathrooms.
  - RSUS conducted a survey among its students, which received 95% positive feedback from 21 responses, only one response against the change.
- Theology Students Undergraduate Association (TUSA)
  - First meeting will be at 12h30 on 18 October, RSUS will send representatives.
  - TUSA has been represented at our meetings since we first liaised.

### **Finances**

- Wine and Cheese finances finalized, budgeted for the costs of food, drink, etc. with considerations for dietary restrictions.
- External funding is now a priority for us to be able to operate.

- Townhall meetings will now be at the beginning of each month and will be advertised to students via Facebook.
