SSMU in General

- The new executive has been elected! Congratulations to our VP Internal who will go onto SSMU next year.
- The fee for Fiat Luxe was introduced to Council but blocked by the Steering Committee due to the Moratorium.
- The Dean of Libraries Colleen Cook gave a presentation to Council what the Fiat Luxe would look like. Her presentation gave us insights into what the finished libraries will look like but also the possible disruptions to students. In addition, despite technical difficulties, the Dean made light of the situation with a decent dose of humour.
- Council passed motions regarding keep.meSafe fee, creation of a services committee, adopting an affordable student housing plan, SSMU referral services fee, plan of clubs as SSMU's highest priority, endorsement of climate strike, amending winter referendum dates, and nomination of Senator Andre Lametti to the Board of Directors.
