1. ESA Economics Department Survey

- The survey is intended to find out the economics students' general opinion about the economics major program overall.

- The survey will begin this week and will end when we have enough responses (>100) so the result is more legitimate.
- Depends on the result of this survey, the economics department may discuss the issues in the committee meeting to consider academic revisions of the economics major program.
