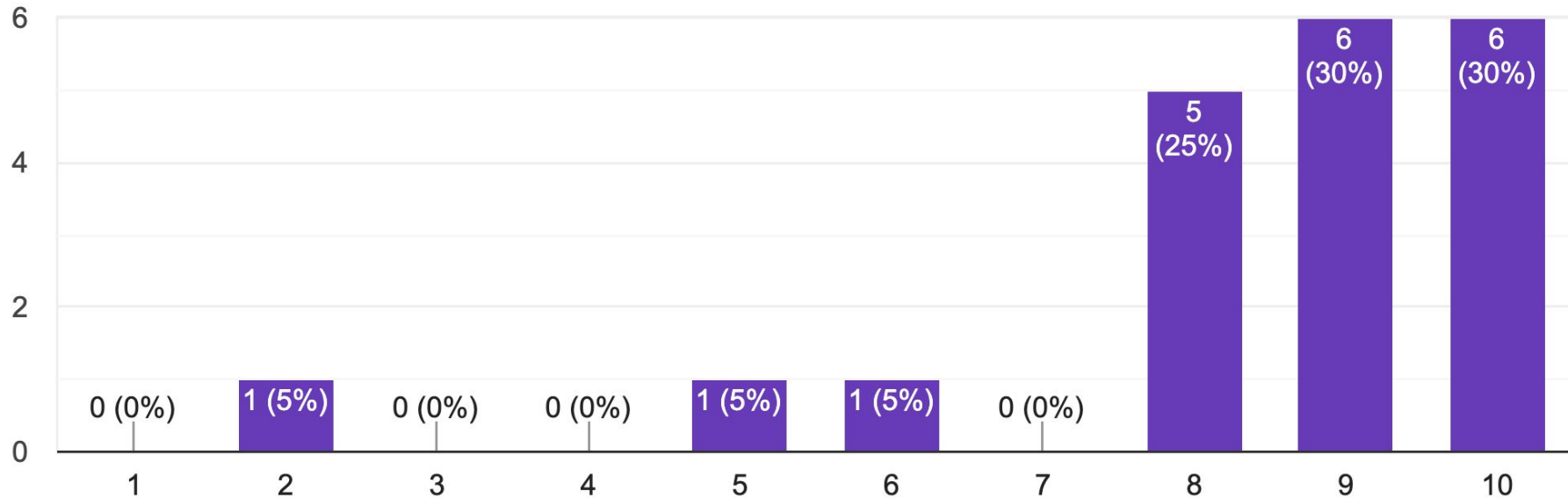




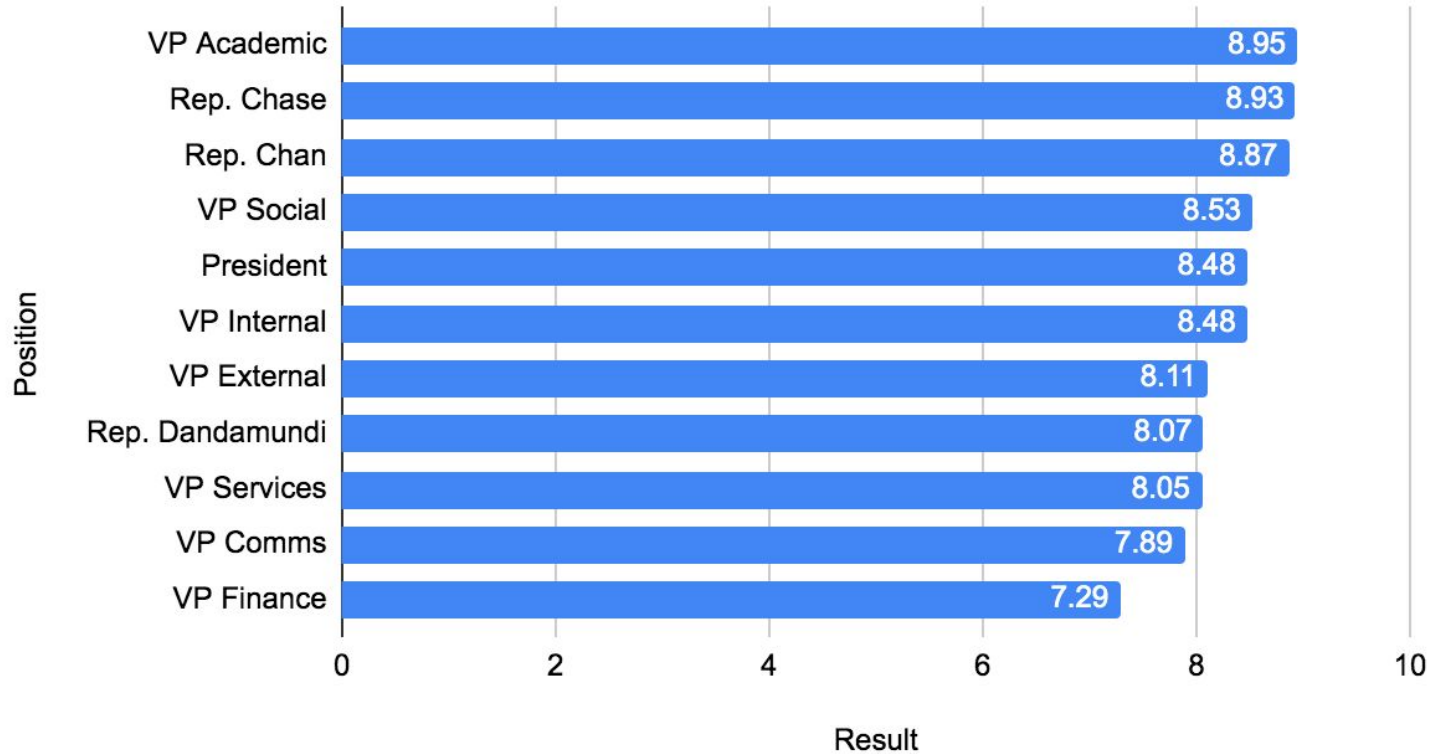
# Executive Accountability Survey Results

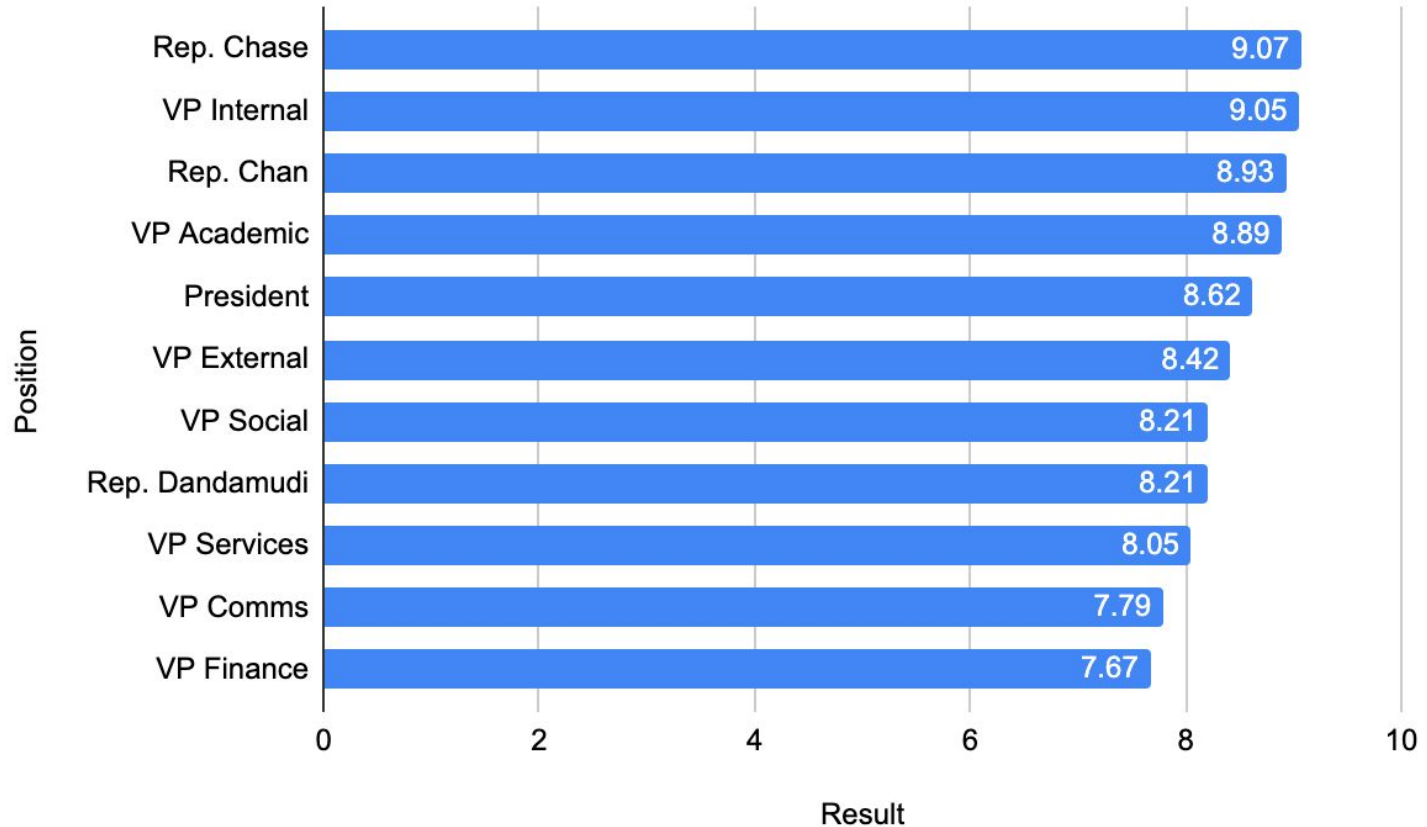

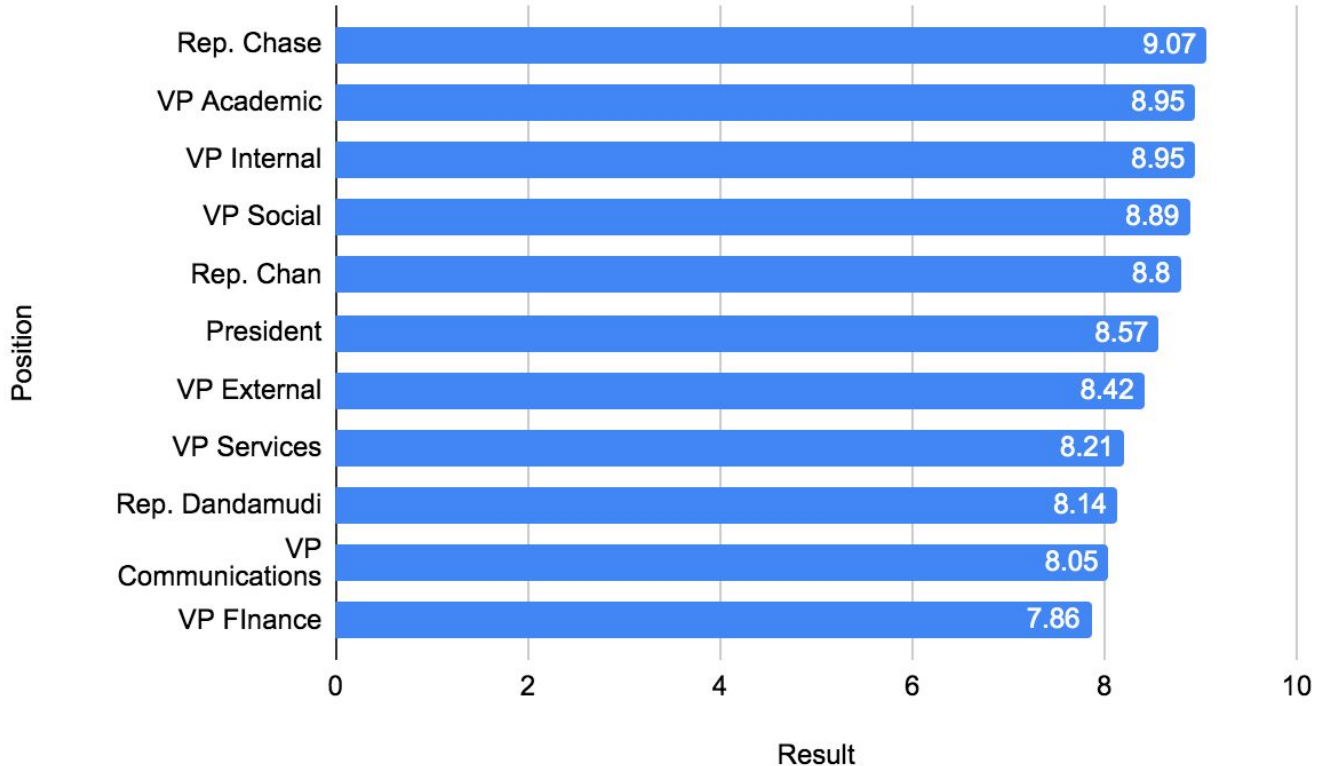
# 1. Do You Approve of the Executive's Conduct?
