Food Sales

- Operational next semester, walkthroughs next council on how the procedure will work

- How the procedure looks right now:
 - Departments won't have to pay for a \$25 permit
 - 1. Departments will request for tables the same way they request for room bookings, through the email request form, not Skedda, and wait confirmation
 - 2. Departments need to prepare warning labels and a list of ingredients in descending quantity and send it to assistants before selling
 - 3. The day of, they will pick up necessary equipment from AUS assistants (hot trays, cleaning equipment, hairnets, gloves)
